BEHAVIOUR AND SAFETY

How you can protect yourself from harm or someone else's bad behaviour

Every person engaged in a PCYC activity or at a Club has the right to enjoy themselves and to feel safe.

If you are a child or young person you do not have to accept behaviour that hurts you, makes fun of you, embarrasses you or makes you feel uncomfortable.

Hints on how to stay safe

- If someone does something bad or embarrassing to you, don't blame yourself. Report it to someone in charge.
- Report bad behaviour to a PCYC Police Officer, staff member, volunteer or senior Club Member as soon as it happens – keeping quiet about it doesn't mean it will go away. If you don't feel you can tell one of these people, tell a parent, guardian or a friend you trust and get them to help you report it.
- Don't think that any bad behaviour is unimportant, or too embarrassing to report, or that the person involved is too important – PCYC Police Officers and staff will treat your report seriously and will respect your privacy.
- If someone does something embarrassing or uncomfortable to you, go to a safe place and tell someone you trust.
- Don't accept bad language, and don't give out private information while you are on the internet or in email. Don't make arrangements to go somewhere or meet someone you have only talked to and met on the internet. If someone asks you over the internet for private information or to meet them, report that to a PCYC Police Officer or PCYC staff member.
- If someone says they are a staff member, volunteer or Club Member and asks you to go somewhere with them, or says they will take you home, ask them for identification and check with another PCYC Police Officer or staff member – don't go with them until a Police Officer or staff member knows the arrangement.
- Help other children or young people – if someone tells you about bad behaviour that hurt them, help them to report it. If you see someone being treated badly, report it to a PCYC Police Officer or PCYC staff member, or someone you know will help.



PRIVACY

PCYC is committed to the Privacy Act 1988 and the Health Records and Information Privacy Act 2002.

For PCYC to conduct its activities and comply with Government law and regulations, it is necessary to collect and use certain kinds of personal information about Club Members. That information includes the information collected in this Membership Form and as a result of being a member. As much as possible, PCYC will only collect such information directly from you, but we may also collect information from a parent, guardian or third party in certain circumstances such as accidents or incident investigations. We will take reasonable steps to ensure that personal information is up-to-date and accurate, complete and secure, and to destroy information when it is not needed.

You may request access to any personal information PCYC holds about you.

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION

PCYC is committed to treating people equally and respecting personal dignity.

PCYC will not discriminate against a person wishing to participate at a Club or in a PCYC activity or become a member on the basis of their sex, ethnic background, age, religious beliefs, sexual preference, marital status, or disability.

PCYC is committed to the welfare and development of young people, and to assisting young people who are disadvantaged to have an equal chance in life — PCYC therefore set some prices and fees to reflect a member's capacity to pay.
